## FLOOD PROTECTION ASSISTANCE

The Lenoir County Planning and Inspections Department, as a public service to all property owners, will review Flood Insurance Rate Maps to determine if a property is in the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) designated Special Flood Hazard Area.

The Planning and Inspections Department will provide a qualified person to discuss the topics concerning flood protection from all inquirers. This assistance will include providing floor elevations, data on historical flooding in the neighborhood, and any similar information so inquirers can relate the flood threat to their own properties.

Assistance will include site visits, as requested, to advise owners on appropriate protection measures. This assistance will also include review and critique of plan retrofitting, performed by the engineering Department. A hand-out will be provided concerning information on how to select a qualified architectural/engineering service or general contractor.
